The Sarcoma Alliance is a 501(c) (3) non-profit organization.

Sarcoma does not discriminate by age, gender, or race. As a rare diagnosis, this is a community who has special needs and requires special attention. Survival depends upon it. The Sarcoma Alliance is working to address the needs of this special community and to get sarcoma patients the necessary resources and attention they deserve.

Every year, 17,000 individuals in the United States face the fear and uncertainty that comes with a new sarcoma diagnosis. For these patients and their loved ones, the Sarcoma Alliance is a crucial source of guidance, education, and support. We provide accurate, clear information during those difficult initial days following diagnosis, second opinion grants to help access quality care, and offer emotional support throughout the journey.

What is Sarcoma?

Malignant (cancerous) tumors of the connective tissues are called "sarcomas". The term sarcoma comes from a Greek word meaning fleshy growth. Sarcoma arises in the connective tissue of the body. Normal connective tissue include, fat, blood vessels, nerves, bones, muscles, deep skin tissues, and cartilage. Sarcomas are divided into two main groups, bone tumors and soft tissue sarcomas. They are further sub-classified based on the type of cell found in the tumor. They all share certain microscopic characteristics and have similar symptoms. Sarcomas can develop in children and adults. For children under 20, approximately 15% of cancer diagnosis are sarcomas. Although rare, there are approximately 17,000 new cases of sarcoma diagnosed each year in the United States.
